"Ferns – A Comprehensive Guide to Growing Ferns for the Home Gardener" by Gillean Dunk

This book is filled with information about ferns – their history; the folklore surrounding them; the structure and life cycle of ferns; pests and diseases, and how to combat them without harsh chemicals; how to successfully propagate and grow ferns in a house, greenhouse, glasshouse, or garden; how to grow ferns in terrariums and hanging baskets; and a list of over 200 species of ferns - readily available from nurseries and growers throughout the world. It is an enjoyable reference for the home gardener, whether expert or beginner.
